Since it appears he was living in Freetown during this time, it is likely the next 3 children, Stephen, Charity and Rebecca were born in Freetown [Freetown VRs]. According to Daniels in *History of Oxford*, Daniel (recorded as David) purchased land in Douglas on 11 November 1760, remaining there until 1768 when he purchased land on Prospect Hill, later Ward which became Auburn. The last child, Daniel, is only listed in the Douglas VRs so was likely born there.
